CALL FOR PAPERS

The Faculty of Law Enforcement of the University of Public Service organizes a symposium dedicated to the current trends of the research conducted in the field of law enforcement with the title 'I. Ludovika International Law Enforcement Research Symposium (LILERS)' in Budapest, in the fall of 2022. The aim of the conference – which intends to start a tradition and will be held annually in the future – is to introduce the current research findings and the newest trends in modern policing, focusing primarily, but not exclusively on Central and Eastern Europe. The participation at the conference is possible online as well through the MS Teams communication platform. Delivering presentations is possible only in person.

THEMATIC AREAS OF THE SYMPOSIUM

1. Cybercrime and IT security
2. Forensic science and criminalistics
3. Law enforcement management and police education
4. Organized crime
5. Public safety
6. Open corner (freely chosen topic in the field of law enforcement)

COSTS

There is no registration fee for the conference. The cost of meals (lunch and dinner) and transportation within Hungary (from and to the airport, between the venues of the conference) will be paid by the University of Public Service. Accommodation will be provided free of charge for 50 participants (according to the decision of the Organizing Committee). There is no registration fee for the online participation either. Travel expenses, insurance and accommodation fees (above the 50 persons limit) have to be paid by the participants (or the sending organization).

TECHNICAL INFORMATION

The conference will have Plenums and Sessions, the working language is English. Abstracts for the conference (including keywords) shall not exceed 300 words and shall be sent in MS Word format until 31 May 2022 to the following e-mail address: LILERS@uni-nke.hu

Please note that only the selected papers will be presented at the conference, but all accepted papers (including those ones, which were not presented) will be published in digital format. The Organizing Committee of the conference will decide on the abstracts until 15 June 2022. You are kindly advised to arrive on 25 October 2022 until 6 pm (welcome dinner). Please do not book your journey back before 27 October 2022, in order to be able to participate the Gala Dinner on 26 October 2022 in the evening.
