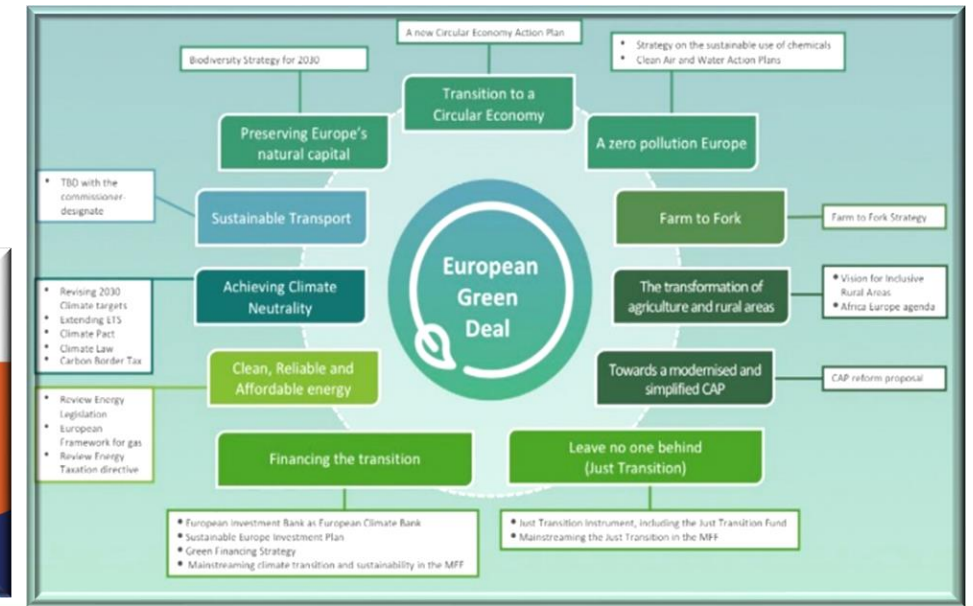

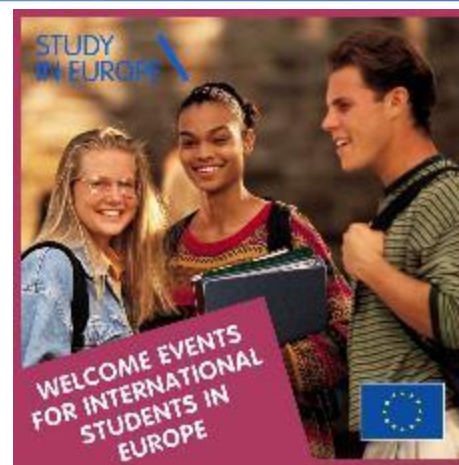

- Individual opportunities for short-term mobility: for school pupils/VET learners/ HEIs students/ adult students – study / traineeship
- Individual opportunities for short-term mobility: for school /VET / HEIs / adult education staff – teaching, training, job shadowing
- Individual opportunities for short-term mobility: for young people, youth workers and young active citizens – key competencies
- Individual opportunities for short-term mobility: for sport coaches

Individuals can apply directly to the organisations which received grants for such projects. Where required by the national or institutional regulations the Inter-institutional Agreements between organisations must be concluded for official mobility and further recognition.

# Steps for changes and impact – KA1. ICM, VET, EVE, Youth

- 1. Mobility projects – building trust** at personal, institutional levels and Ukraine!!!
  - Establish contacts and discuss cooperation, learn how to present your institution, how to communicate about your university needs (SWOT).
  - Learn how the international cooperation is organised, what procedures and mechanisms are established, learn how to write proposals and do it together.
  - Bring prominent lectures for internationalisation at home, organise joint virtual classes, youth dialogue via virtual exchanges!
  - Learn how the educational process is organised what are the digital tools to make it operated easier!
  - Additionally: arrange meetings with other universities, faculties, find contracts for future partnership etc.
  - Organise a meeting with students – promote Ukraine and your HEI as study destination!
  - Organise summer/winter schools for youth people, including students – youth dialogue

# KA 1. Higher Education and VET: Staff mobility from Ukraine to EU with institutional impact and complementarity – ideas

- Staff teaching, training and job shadowing – Ukrainian staff:
- Participation in European University Alliances activities and events.
- Develop courses in foreign languages (incorporate as elective or core) – for future foreign students and incoming mobility to Ukraine.
- Learn how to design and develop concepts for the Joint Programmes: courses, processes, procedures, methodologies: match Learning Outcome.
- Design practical courses, labs based on innovative software, simulators, virtual/added reality (virtual patient, modeling, virtual labs etc.).
- Develop concept of digitalisation of the educational process based on the expertise in host university: how it is organised, processes and procedures.
- Learn about organisation of international cooperation, ECHE, mobility unit, COIL etc.
- Project writing courses – develop proposals to apply for Erasmus+ HorizonEurope...



# KA 1.

## Staff mobility to Ukraine (virtual during the war) – ideas

- Teaching courses/ guest lecturers/ workshops / practical labs and simulators.
- Support to develop courses in foreign languages (elective or core) – potentially interesting for students from home university to Ukraine.
- Support to design the Joint Programmes: courses, processes, procedures, methodologies, match/tune Learning Outcome.
- Support to design practical courses – labs based on innovative software, simulators, virtual/added reality (virtual patient, modeling etc.).
- Support to develop concept of digitalisation of the educational process based on the expertise in host university: how it is organised, processes and procedures.
- Support to develop strategy, processes and procedures for international cooperation, mobility, recognition etc. **Discuss specifics of the ECHE Guideline for further signature.**
- Provide courses and develop proposals to apply for Erasmus+ HorizonEurope together.

# Steps for changes and impact – KA2 CBHE/CBVET

**2. Capacity Building projects** – developing capability of newcomers and innovative capacity of experienced partners at human, resources and infrastructure for teaching and learning excellence!

- Based on EU experience and expertise!
- Joint research and studies
- Content – new expertise and interactive teaching and learning materials
- New and innovative methodologies and technologies
- Modern resources, open data, open science
- Modernise programme/courses/modules (joint programmes)
- Equipment as tools: virtual and added reality, simulators, virtual labs etc.
- Or
- Modernise processes and procedures of the university governance, univ. autonomy, international cooperation, improve students services etc.

# Capacity building projects higher education, VET, youth and sport

- Curricula modernisation or development of new innovative in Ukrainian and foreign languages and embedded window for mobility.
- TOT on professional innovations and on Teaching and Learning excellence.
- Language courses for staff, students, learners and youth development.
- Joint Programmes development from the scratch.
- Courses in foreign languages (elective or core) – for future foreign students and incoming mobility to Ukraine.
- Blended or hybrid approaches and technologies, platforms, virtual labs etc.
- Access to courses and resources.
- Purchase and usage as tool – virtual labs, innovative software, simulators, virtual/added reality, platforms for university / mobility management etc.
