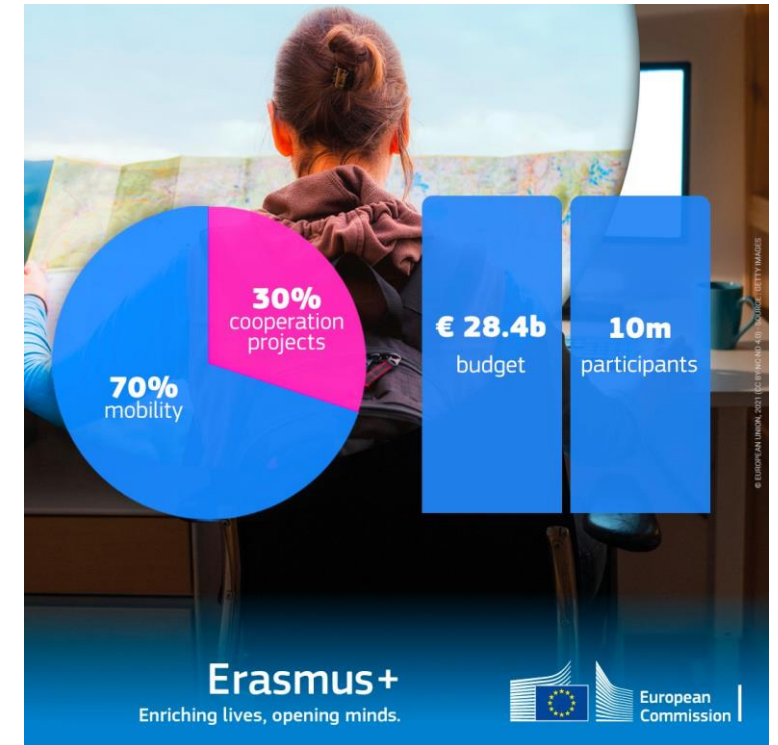

Digital ERASMUS+

Erasmus+ will support the development of digital skills, in line with the Digital Education Action Plan. It will provide high-quality digital training and exchanges, and it will encourage traineeships in the digital sector. New formats, such as blended intensive programmes, will allow short-term physical mobility abroad to be complemented with online learning and teamwork. The implementation will be further digitalised and simplified with the European Student Card.

EU Youth Strategy

The EU developed an EU Youth Strategy and wants young people to engage and become an active citizen involved in democracy and society. We want young people to tell us what is important to them by taking part in the EU Youth Dialogue.

Virtual Exchange?

Virtual Exchange is a (umbrella) term used to describe "*technology-enabled, sustained, people-to-people education programs*" (*Virtual Exchange Collation*), in which sustained communication and interaction takes place between individuals or groups who are geographically separated, with the support of educators and/or facilitators.

Defining Collaborative Online International Learning

What is COIL?

Not a technology, but a new teaching and learning paradigm that develops intercultural competence across shared multi-cultural online learning environments.

- A tool used to enhance internationalisation at home (IaH)
- A teaching method/approach
- Integrated into the curriculum at course level
- It aims to enhance the intercultural competencies of students who might not otherwise have the opportunity to study abroad.
- Develops the skills students need to work in intercultural and virtual online teams.
- A networked based learning approach

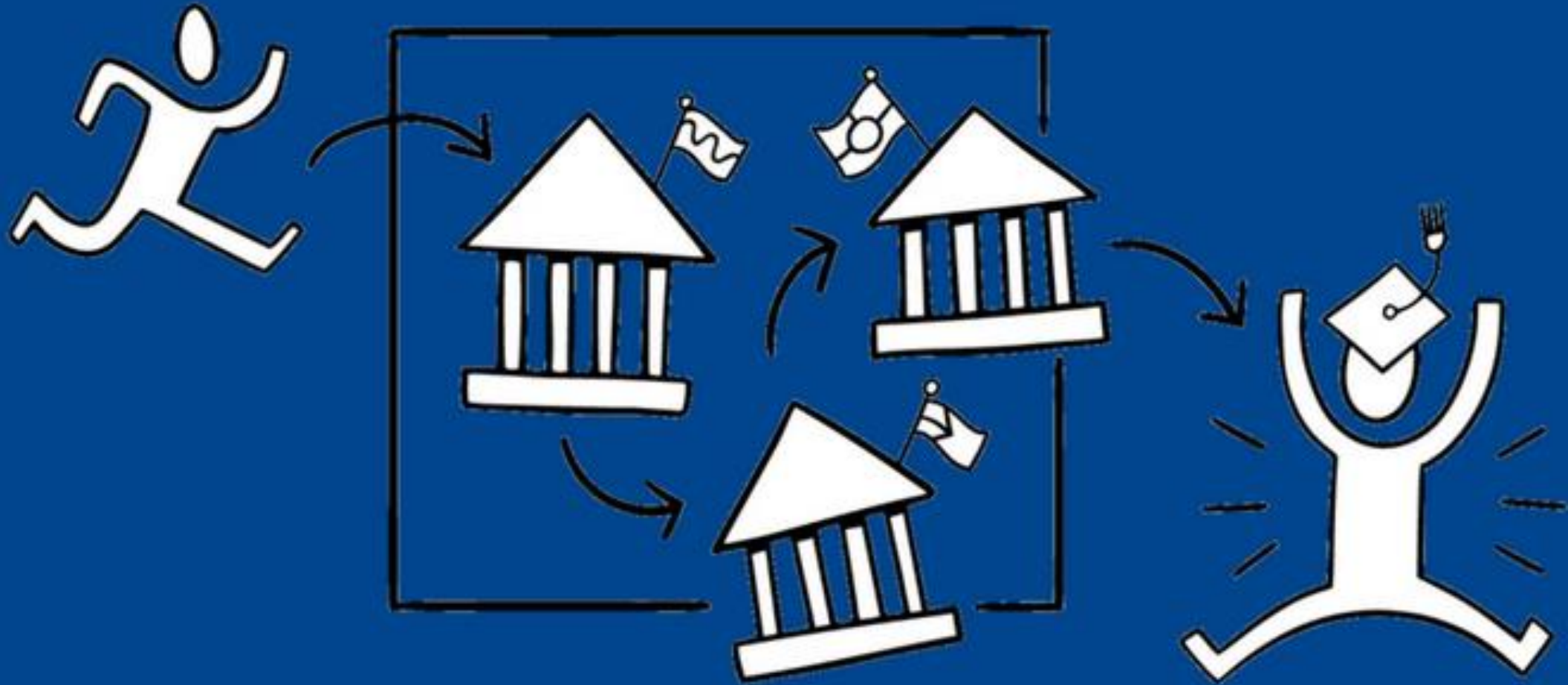

Erasmus Mundus Joint Masters (EMJM)

- Excellent integrated Master courses offered by consortia of 3+ full partner HEIs from three different countries, of which **at least two must be EU Member States or Associated third countries**
- Attract best students worldwide through EU-funded scholarships
- Duration: 6 academic years covering at least 4 editions of the master programme
- 1 to 2 academic years (60, 90 or 120 ECTS credits) with **study in 2+ countries, of which at least one must be an EU MS or Associated third country**
- Institutions from **all over the world** may submit a proposal on behalf of an international consortium

Erasmus Mundus Design Measures (EMDM)

- New sub-action, supporting the design of high-level study programmes at master level
- An EM Design Measures project involves at least 3 full partner HEIs from three different countries, of which **at least two must be EU Member States or Associated third countries**
- Independent call for proposals
- Fixed duration of 15 months
- Institutions from **all over the world** may submit a proposal on behalf of an international consortium

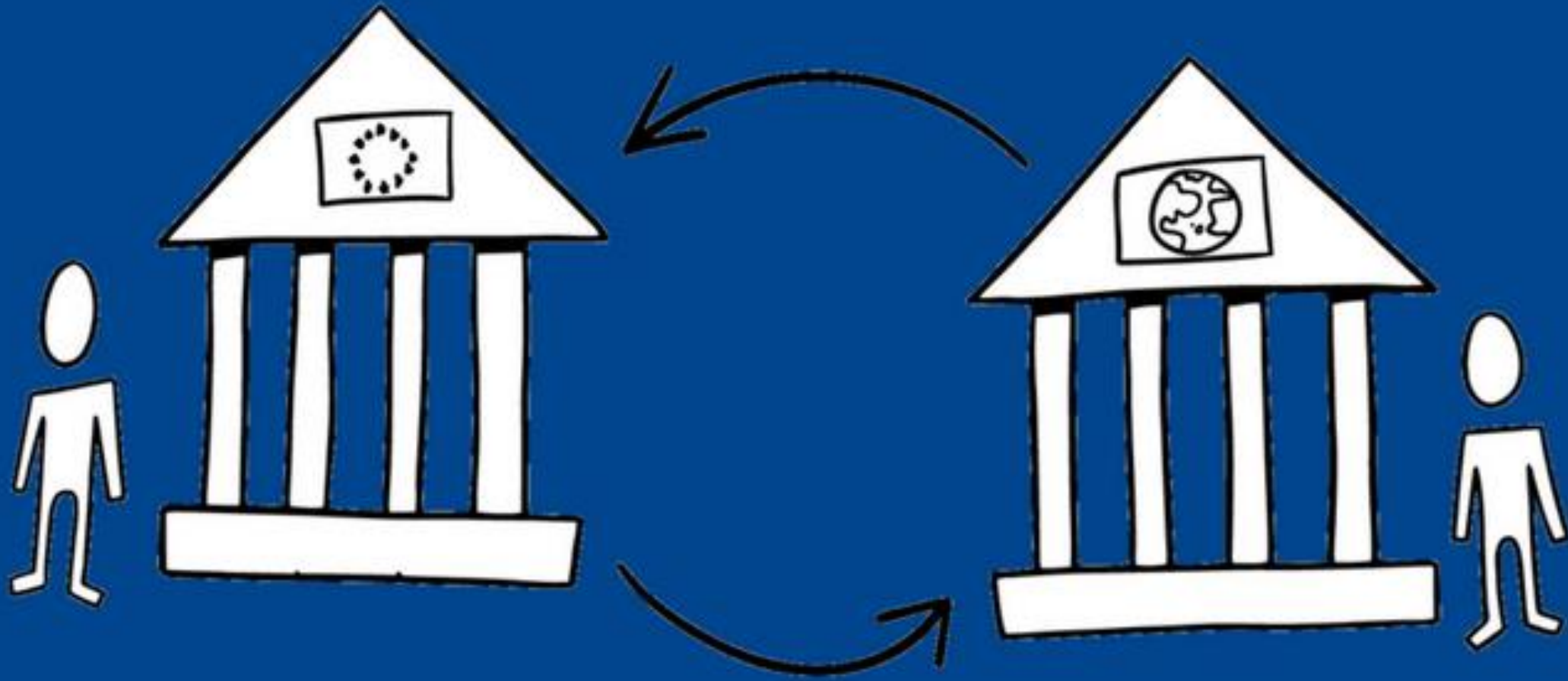

International credit mobility



International credit mobility



- Short-term studies or traineeships abroad (2-12 months) that count to a degree back home
- At bachelor, master and doctoral level...
- ...and for staff (5 days – 2 months)
- Grants to cover travel and living costs
- HEIs from EU MS and associated third countries may apply to their National Agency



Capacity building for higher education



- 2-3 year Partnerships of HEIs from EU MS and associated third countries and non-associated third countries
- Three types of project
 - **FOSTERING ACCESS TO COOPERATION IN HE:**
 - smaller scope projects focused on universities – priority to newcomers - €200-400k
 - **PARTNERSHIPS FOR INNOVATION IN HE**
 - larger-scale projects focused on innovation, university/business and governance € 400-800k
 - **STRUCTURAL REFORM PROJECTS** focus on the macro level (policy reforms to foster internationalisation) and require involvement of ministries.
